CARB Compliance – What You Need to Know, What You Need to Do

A special optional workshop will be held at HPVA's Tampa Convention on Wednesday, May 7th to help attendees understand their obligations under the new California Air Resources Board *Airborne Toxic Control Measure to Reduce Formaldehyde Emissions from Composite Wood Products*. Topics addressed will include an update on Phase 1 and Phase 2 formaldehyde emission limits, a projected compliance timeline, exemptions from the regulation for certain products, exemptions from third-party certification for NAF and ULEF resin systems, and requirements for other provisions in the regulation such as product labeling, recordkeeping, quality assurance testing, third-party certification, and disposition of non-compliant products.

The CARB Workshop will run from 8:30 AM to 11:00 AM.
