AS A WOODWORK INSTITUTE AFFILIATE, WE AND OUR STAFF, WILL...

- 1. Be fair and take action not to discriminate or cause harm to others while respecting the values of equality, tolerance, and equal justice.
- 2. Not do anything which compromises or which is likely to compromise the impartiality of those who work for, or on behalf of, the Institute.
- Be honest and trustworthy, not make deliberate false or deceptive claims, be honest about my qualifications, and about circumstances that might lead to conflicts of interest.
- 4. Exercise care not to misrepresent the Institute, its positions and/or policies, nor conduct myself in a manner to bring my position as a member into disrepute.

- Know, respect and follow the policies and/or procedures of the Institute while acknowledging and supporting proper authorized use of the Institute's resources.

- 10. Uphold principles of this Code and promote the same of other WI Affiliates and their staff.
- 11. Treat violations of this code as inconsistent with proper WI Affiliate behavior and understand that by engaging in gross misconduct, my WI Affiliate may be terminated.
